

6.4 WIRES Facebook Community Guidelines

Adopted at the Council Meeting of 6 April 2013

We welcome your participation as a means of sharing your comments, own experiences, suggesting improvements, etc. To keep our Facebook pages focused, we have some guidelines.

1. All of our Facebook pages are moderated and all comments/messages are reviewed by us.
2. To ensure exchanges that are productive, informative, respectful of diverse viewpoints and lawful, we will review all comments and we will delete any comments that are or include:
 - a. Spam: Comments focused on selling a product or service, or comments posted for a purpose of driving traffic to a particular website for personal, political or monetary gain, will be removed.
 - b. Personal Attacks including but not limited to defaming, abusing, harassing, stalking, threatening or violating the legal rights of others. If you disagree with the content produced by either us or a member of the community, we'd like to hear from you, but ask that you refrain from personal attacks or being disrespectful of others. Malicious intent and or participation not in the spirit of civil conversation will be removed.
 - c. Offensive Language: Comments including but not limited to, profane or provocative language will be removed (which means that hateful, racially or ethnically offensive or derogatory content, threats, obscene or sexually explicit language will not be tolerated).
 - d. Abuse or cruelty to animals: Comments including content advocating, condoning or encouraging any form of abuse or cruelty to any animal.
 - e. Publishing, posting, distributing or disseminating any defamatory, infringing, obscene, indecent, misleading or unlawful material or information.
 - f. Content that WIRES, in their sole discretion believes to be irrelevant to the activities of WIRES.
 - g. Uploads or attaches files that contain viruses, corrupted files, or any other similar software or programs that may damage the operation of another's computer.
 - h. Private or Confidential Information. Please do not provide any of your specific account details or other personal information; this extends to private addresses, email accounts, Facebook logins etc.
